Venue

BEXCO (Busan Exhibition & Convention Center) is Busan's centerpiece for all economic enterprises and is one of the proudest hotspots in Northeast Asia for hosting international exhibitions, conventions, and concerts. In 2005, BEXCO administered APEC (Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation), which is an economic forum for a group of Pacific Rim countries that represent 60% of the world economy.

Nurimaru APEC House presides at the tip of Dong-baek Island, which is acclaimed for its sea-side charms, and overlooks a quaint garden, the Gwangan Bridge, and the Oryukdo Islets. Nuri-maru literally means "world summit" and is deemed as "the hub of international dialogues" by Busan city officials. It is a round three-story building modeled after *Seokguram*, the famous Korean cave temple, and has a traditional Korean interior decoration.

- Mean Temperature: 21.3 °C
- Max. Temperature: 25.2 °C
- Min. Temperature: 18.6 °C

Transportation

From Incheon Airport to Gimhae Airport (Busan)

A. Direct

- Move from the arrival floor (1st) to the departure floor (3rd).
- Take the domestic flight to Gimhae Airport (takes 1 hour).

B. Via Gimpo

- Take the airport limousine bus to Gimpo Domestic Flight Terminal (takes about 35 minutes)
- Ticket can be purchased at the Transportation Information Counter (near the exit No. 2,4,9,13) on the arrival floor (1st) of passenger terminal.
- The ticket costs KRW 6,000 (about USD 6).
- The non-stop airport limousine bus to Gimpo departs every 5 to 10 minutes at bus stops of "3B", "10B", "4B" and "11A".
- Take the domestic flight to Gimhae Airport (takes 1 hour)

From Gimhae Airport to BEXCO and Paradise Hotel

The airport limousine from Gimhae Airport will stop at both BEXCO and Paradise Hotel. Please take the airport limousine on 'line no.2' that departs for Paradise Hotel every 20 minutes. From BEXCO, the same airport limousine will also depart for Paradise Hotel. The ticket for the airport limousine costs KRW 6,000 and can be purchased at the airport limousine.
